FROM THE PASTOR

On Tuesday, September 8, the Institute of the Good Shepherd will celebrate the twentieth anniversary of its foundation. To mark this special occasion of thanksgiving, His Holiness Pope Leo XIV has granted a Plenary Indulgence, applicable to oneself or the souls in Purgatory, to all the faithful who devoutly participate in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass on this day in any church or oratory served by the priests of the Institute. The text of the Decree can be found on the next page.

To obtain this spiritual gift, the faithful must fulfill the usual conditions of the Church, which include receiving Sacramental Confession within several days of the feast, worthily receiving Holy Communion on the day itself, praying for the intentions of the Holy Father, and maintaining a complete detachment from all sin, even venial sin.

All the faithful are cordially invited to join the community for this beautiful celebration of grace, fidelity, and spiritual renewal.

As a still very young community growing steadily with 65 priests and 50 seminarians, this anniversary is a profound occasion to thank God for His blessings and to ask the Blessed Virgin Mary to intercede for the community, that it may always fulfill God's will faithfully and truthfully.

Confessions are heard 30 minutes before each Mass. The church remains open after these services conclude until the 5:00 PM closing time.

Decree of Indulgences granted by Holy Father Pope Leo on the occasion of the twentieth anniversary of the Institute of the Good Shepherd

On the occasion of the twentieth anniversary of the foundation of the Institute of the Good Shepherd, Our Most Holy Father Leo XIV, by Divine Providence Vicar on earth of Our Lord Jesus Christ, continuing to show his paternal affection toward all the Christian faithful, and in a particular way toward the members and faithful attached to the said Institute, has most graciously granted the indulgences described below, so that this anniversary may be solemnly celebrated as a special time of thanksgiving and sanctification, and so that the faithful, exhorted to the full remission of sins and to a deeper union with Christ and with the Church, may be able to draw more abundantly from the treasury of the Church. Therefore:

I. A plenary indulgence, applicable to the living and the deceased and obtainable under the usual conditions, is granted to the faithful who, on a single day to be designated by the Superiors of the individual houses and churches entrusted to the Institute, between September 1, 2026, and September 30, 2027, while solemnly celebrating the aforementioned anniversary, devoutly participate in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass or in another sacred celebration of thanksgiving, either in the oratory of any house of the Institute or in a church served by priests of the same Institute, even if only on that day.

II. A plenary indulgence, applicable to the living and the deceased and obtainable under the usual conditions, is likewise granted to the faithful who devoutly participate in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass:

- On September 8, 2026;
- On September 8, 2027;
- On April 11, 2027, the Sunday known as “Good Shepherd Sunday,” the patronal feast of the Institute of the Good Shepherd;

in all oratories and churches served by priests of the same Institute, even if only on that day.

III. The same indulgence may also be obtained by the faithful who, because of a grave reason or an impediment due to ill health, are unable to be personally present at the celebrations, provided that, having detached themselves from all sin, they devoutly unite themselves spiritually to the sacred celebrations and, as soon as possible, fulfill the standard conditions required for obtaining the indulgence.

May this special grant of indulgences, graciously made by Our Most Holy Lord Leo XIV on the occasion of the twentieth anniversary of the foundation of the Institute of the Good Shepherd, serve to foster the devotion of the Christian faithful and to enable them to obtain more abundant spiritual fruit from this anniversary, so that all who wish to avail themselves of these concessions may be ever more earnestly moved to a true conversion of heart, to the frequent reception of the Sacraments, and to a greater charity toward God and neighbor.
