FROM THE PASTOR

This weekend is the official launch of the New Hampshire Catholic Appeal. Last year we have fundraised \$11,670.68 with only 38 donors! Thank you very much for your participation!

This year, we must fundraise \$16,496.00. You have received emails, mails, and information throughout the year with reports and posters. We are well informed about the funds and its use.

Currently in our parish, we have 99 families and individuals who come to Mass. Only 38 families and individuals gave last year! The highest gifts were \$1200 from one family, \$1000 from two families, \$750 from another one, \$500 from a few.

We all benefit from the Church, the Diocese, the Parish but what do we give? *But thou shalt give to him: neither shalt thou do any thing craftily in relieving his necessities: that the Lord thy God may bless thee at all times, and in all things to which thou shalt put thy hand.* Deut, 15, 10. *Give, and it shall be given to you: good measure and pressed down and shaken together and running over shall they give into your bosom. For with the same measure that you shall mete withal, it shall be measured to you again.* Luke, 6, 38.

Baptism:

Registered and active parishioners should call well ahead of the baptism to get the form. A class will be provided. The form should be submitted before the ceremony.

Holy Matrimony:

Catholics must be married in the Catholic Church to have a valid marriage in the eyes of God and the Catholic Church. There is a six-month preparation prior the desired date of wedding. It is available for registered and active parishioners.

First Confession, First Holy Communion & Confirmation:

Preparation for the reception of sacraments is available for families registered and active at the parish. The preparation is announced before the beginning of the academic year. Adults who didn't receive some sacraments or who have questions about their reception should talk to the Pastor who will advise the candidates.
