### First Confession, First Holy Communion & Confirmation:

Preparation for the reception of sacraments is available for families registered and active at the parish. The preparation is announced before the beginning of the academic year. Adults who didn't receive some sacraments or who have questions about their reception should talk to the Pastor who will advise the candidates.

*Memorial of Our Lady of the Rosary. By praying the Rosary, the Christian people invoke the help of the holy Mother of God, meditating under her guidance on the mysteries of Christ, she who was uniquely associated with the incarnation, passion and resurrection of the Son of God.*

#### *Roman Martyrology*

The Order of Saint Dominic is the religious order that spread the Holy Rosary. Saint Dominic instituted the Rosary at the beginning of the 13th century.

The Feast of Our Lady of Victory was instituted by Pius V on the first Sunday of October, in thanksgiving for the victory of Lepanto.

Later, in the early years of the 18th century, Saint Louis-Marie Grignion de Montfort became the apostle of the Rosary. He was the most zealous missionary since Dominic. He himself composed a method of reciting the Rosary, easy to remember, instructive and pious.

By his daily Rosary, Montfort converted the greatest sinners and made them persevere in the grace and fervor of their conversion; he could say: "No one has resisted me once I was able to get their hands on him with my Rosary!"

He spread the love for the Rosary to many people. He wrote the Secret of the Rosary. It is profitable to read the book especially during the month of the Rosary.

He also wrote hymns to say the Rosary. It is possible to sing it. Today, in pilgrimages, people sing the Rosary while walking.

#### **FROM THE PASTOR**

Pope Leo XIII in his encyclical *Supremi Apostolatus officio* published in 1883, promulgated the month of October being the month of the Most Holy Rosary. He encouraged all parishes to say devoutly the 5 decades of the Rosary followed by Mass and Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament after which the faithful will be blessed with the Most Holy Sacrament. This is what is called now the Office of the Rosary.

When I arrived in September 2021, I decided to do the Office fo the Rosary every day of October which was done. It is a great devotion encouraged by all Popes. I enjoyed the Office of the Rosary when I was a seminarian. It was said every day of October and May. The office starts with the Exposition and regular hymns followed by the 5 decades after which are read the Litanies of Loreto. Finally, the blessing is given. What a blessing for us to say it that way I emphasized! Some days, we were 5 people only. Once it happened, I started it alone in front of Our Lord and I was joined by one person. What is preventing us to come?

This year, we decided to do it again, as we say the Rosary every day as a community. You are all most welcome to join us! It will be for the intentions of the parish. Can you make that effort? Even once a week?

To me, it is important to have the Rosary said publicly as I stated to my confreres: "As we insist on people to say the Rosary as a family, we should do it ourselves as we are a family, and we invite the parishioners." All agreed! We invite you to come this year. Every day, we will send a Flocknote text for updates and reminder, especially if the schedule changes. Take this opportunity to increase your Marian devotion.
