#### **FROM THE PASTOR**

If you visit the Louvre Museum in Paris, you can stand before one of Leonardo da Vinci's final and most mysterious masterpieces: *Saint John the Baptist*. In the painting, Saint John emerges from a dark, shadowed background. He looks directly at the viewer with a knowing smile, but his most striking feature is his right arm. It is bent across his chest, with one single index finger pointing directly upward into the light. He points the world toward its Savior.

John's intense love for God was defined by a radical, joyful humility. When his own disciples grew jealous that crowds were leaving him to follow Jesus, John corrected them with absolute joy, comparing himself merely to the "best man" at a wedding. He famously insisted: *"He must increase, but I must decrease"* John 3:30. In the desert, he lived on locusts and wild honey, stripping away every earthly comfort so that his voice could cleanly echo the truth of God. He loved God so fiercely that he eventually laid down his life, refusing to compromise the truth before King Herod.

Like the figure in Da Vinci's painting, our lives as Catholics are meant to mimic the Precursor. We are not the source of the light; we are simply called to point to it. As we celebrate Saint John's birth this Wednesday, June 24, let us look at our own lives. In our families, our workplaces, and our struggles, are we pointing others toward Christ? Let us pray for a double portion of the Precursor's humility and love, so that everything we do points upward to the Lamb of God.
